MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES

2. **BM** still to contact Municipality regarding exam for policing
3. **BM** is still to have meeting in connection with Finance with the Municipal Manager as to when we will receive the "release of funds" from the Government. E-mail sent to the government on the 23<sup>rd</sup> February (see letter from **BM** to Municipal Manager 16<sup>th</sup> March) No reply as yet. **BM** suggested we use attorneys to approach the Municipality. **JR** suggested we approach the Finance Manager in force. **BM** to arrange a meeting.
4. **BM** and **BB** have completed the budget, which has been sent to the Municipality.
5. DREDGING  
**JR** said a decision needs to be made regarding the dredging. The dredging contractor we wish to use needs to be informed soonest as he needs to move his dredger if we can't use him.
6. GENERAL  
An FNB account has been opened.

**BM** confirmed that we had received four applications for the post of Manager for the canals. These were discussed and it was decided to hire Mr. P. Grobblaar.

9. **JR** to talk to A. Kantor regarding the repairing of the Jetty he erected at the small boat harbour.
