

MINUTES OF THE SFBRHA MEETING HELD ON

1. The minutes of the previous meeting were not available as B. Robson was away.
2. A discussion was held as to if we should enforce the R10/day parking fee for trailers at the small boat harbour as there were now too many trailers being left there. It was decided that we would have a sign made saying that no trailers were to be left parked on the grass as this was an area meant for picnicking etc.
3. JR reported that the "No Wake" signs were ready and could be collected and need to be erected.
4. JR also reported that he had received a complaint about there being no retaining wall on the beach at the new house just completed by Jean Hugo. It was felt that this was against the regulations as there were no retaining walls at all and the whole frontage of the house was beach. AP to look into the rules and to draw up a specification regarding beaches.
5. Pieter Grobbelaar reported that the canal walls of stands 792 and 756 need to be repaired. The poles around the Harley street bridge are also in need of repair. It was suggested that maybe they should be removed. Shore Road bridge walkway is still in need of urgent repair. PG needs an extra "Canal Warden" sign. A warning letter to be issued to boats parked illegally at jetties.
The interior of the toilets at the small boat harbour and the Cove needs to be painted. The urinal is blocked PG to call Bob Meikle. JR suggested we cut the wood from the old jetties and use it to build the walkway over the spit. BM said this should be done only after dredging is completed. BM reported that Mike Morrison had offered to do some plans on beautifying the small boat harbour free of charge (Thank you Mike) JR to speak to Kipper re cleaning up around the harbour. JR also reported that the Council had banned Jet skis from using the river. BM to attempt to produce a schedule of finances received from the Council and paid over to us.
