1. Matters arising from Previous Minutes

**PG** has numbered the jetties.

**PG** reported that Willie has started at Bird Island, the poles have been paid for and given to Willie.

**JR** to check if Marge Lehana has paid W. Illenburger.

**CB** W. Illenburger said that sandbags would not work in St Francis. He also said that the rock revetment was a good example of what should be done.

**PBM** said that the Danes had asked if we could wait until February next yeas to see the results of their project. **CB** said that we still needed rock revetment.

**SG** asked if there was a system to see if the beach was improving. **PG** said that A. Hodgkins had been on the beach and taken some measurements. **JR** said that the Danes also had an extensive record of the height of the beach.
